

PRESIDENT'S CUP FOUR BALL
MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP
RULES THAT GOVERN PLAY

1. Participants will be required to make these matches a PRIORITY in their schedule, as the rules regarding deadlines will be enforced. It is hoped that this system will make the event enjoyable for all players.
2. **HANDICAPS:** USGA recommendation of 90%. Each match will **play off the lowest handicapped player** in the match. The lowest handicap player in the match will be adjusted to a 0 handicap, and all other players' handicaps will be adjusted up or down accordingly. **All players must have at least 10 rounds posted to their handicap records between April 1, 2025, and April 1, 2026.**
3. U.S.G.A. Match Play rules will govern all play of these matches.
4. **TEES:** The "WHITE TEES" are the OFFICIAL TOURNAMENT tees for this event, with the following exception:

MULTIPLE TEE POLICY:

If a player is a minimum of 65 years of age, and their "WHITE TEE" handicap plus their age is equal to or higher than 80, the player has the option to move up to a forward set of tees and acquire the handicap respective to the selected set of tees (i.e., Gold Tee Handicap if Gold Tees selected). The set of tees designated by each player at registration will remain the same for the duration of the season-long President's Cup tournament.
5. 14 CLUB RULE IS IN EFFECT for all matches.
6. Matches may be played on any day of the week, but must be decided by the DEADLINE DATE, which is posted above the match to be played. In the event teams can not agree on the date to play their match, the match will be awarded to the team that shows up on the 1st tee, ready to play, at 11:00am on the date of the posted deadline. If neither team shows up on the deadline date, the Golf Professional staff will decide the winner by a coin toss. It should be noted that one player may represent the team in a match.
7. **EXTENSIONS:** There will be **NO** extensions given. There are approximately three weeks between the deadline dates, and this has been deemed sufficient time to complete the matches. Any match not completed by the deadline will be decided by a coin flip if no representative from either team is on the 1st tee at 11:00am on the day of the deadline.
8. If inclement weather interferes with the play of a match on the deadline date only, the Golf Committee will authorize a new deadline date for all matches involved.
9. **SUBSTITUTION** may be made for one of the players if that player becomes **ILL OR INJURED** for an extended period of time. The substituted player then becomes the permanent player for the remaining matches. The Committee must be informed of any substitutions prior to any match.
10. The Golf Committee and/or Golf Professional will interpret or clarify the above rules governing play for the President's Cup Four Ball Championship.
